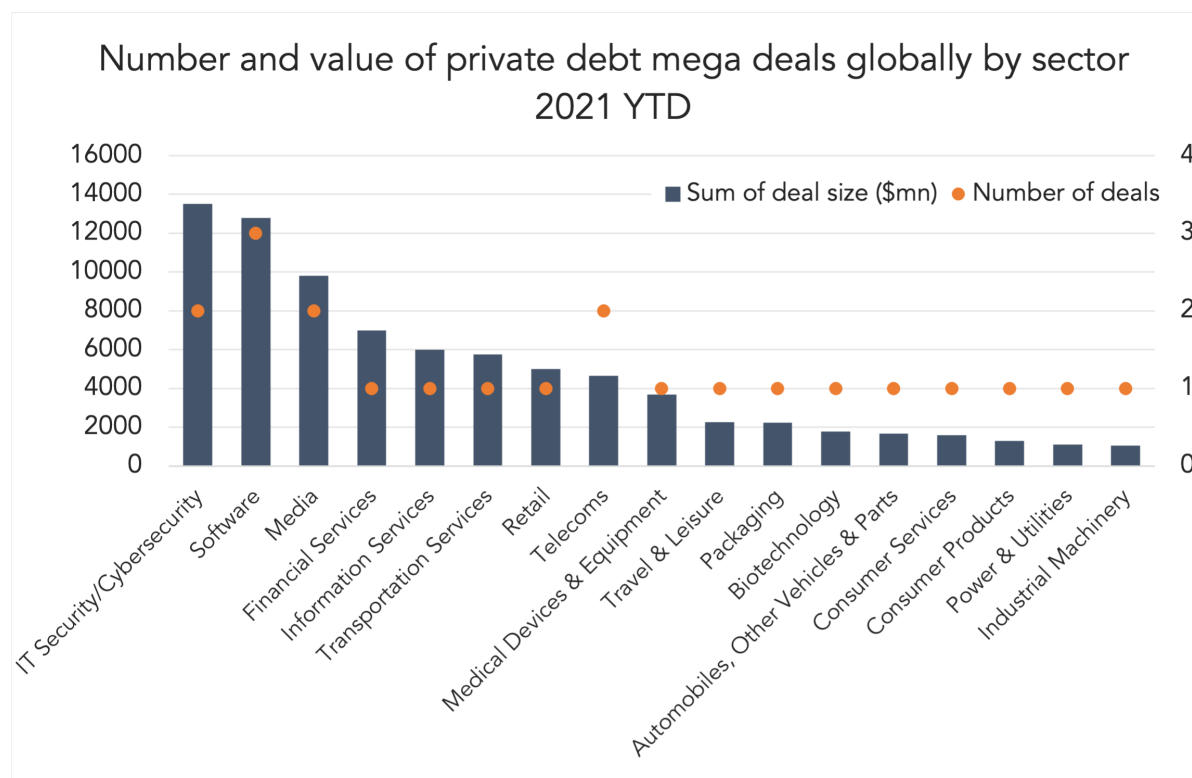

Cybersecurity and software drive mega deal trend in private debt

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2021 has seen 22 private debt megadeals (\$1bn+ deals) so far, three of which were in the software sector and two of which were in IT security/cybersecurity. The biggest was the \$12.3bn all-cash acquisition of US cybersecurity company Proofpoint by Thoma Bravo, which [Fitch Ratings](#) said was part-financed with a \$2.6bn first lien secured loan, an \$800mn second lien secured loan, and a \$250mn secured RCF. The Proofpoint deal helped push the total megadeal value for IT security to \$13.5bn, slightly more than the \$12.8bn in software.
